# Award: Toastmaster of the Year (District Stage)

---

## Criteria:

- A member who makes outstanding contribution to the District.
- The member should fulfil the requirements in the prescribed form (available on the District website).

## Eligibility:

- The member should have joined Toastmasters on or after July 1, 2020.
- The member should be in good standing of a club in good standing.
- One Award per Division.

## Process:

- The application for 'Toastmaster of the Year' should be sent to the respective Area Director by March 31, 2022. The Area Directors will select and forward 2 nominations to their Division Directors by April 10, 2022. The Division Directors will then recommend the top two, by April 20, 2022, to the District Director. The District Director's decision will be final.

# Award: Distinguished Toastmaster (District stage)

---

## Criteria:

- Members achieving Distinguished Toastmaster (DTM) status between July 1, 2021, and June 30, 2022.

## Eligibility:

- A member in good standing of a club in good standing.
- No limitation on the number of eligible members.

## Process:

- The Dashboard should reflect the award by June 30, 2022.

## Recognition:

- DTM pin

# Award: Education Goal Contributor

---

## Criteria:

- Any member completing Level 4 & 5 from Same path between July 1, 2021, to April 15, 2022.

## Eligibility:

- Member in a good standing of a club in a good standing & not eligible for Pathways Star Award.

## Process:

- Verified through dashboard.

## Recognition:

- Trophy/Plaque for the member.

# Award: Pathways Star

---

## Criteria:

- Member to complete one whole path between July 1, 2021, to April 15, 2022.

## Eligibility:

- Member in a good standing of a club in a good standing.

## Process:

- Verified through dashboard.

## Recognition:

- Respective Pathways Pin for the member.

# Award: Guiding Star

---

## Criteria:

- All Club officers needs to be trained within 15 days of Club Charter.
- To conduct at least 2 Educational sessions from 'Club Success Series' and at least one from the 'Better Speaker Series' within 6 months of Club Charter.

## Eligibility:

- Only Club Mentor of the clubs Chartered on or after May 1, 2021, are eligible.
- Should have attended at least 10 Club meetings.
- Mentor credit awarded by TI on Dashboard.

## Process:

- President/VP Education of New club needs to send sign off Email to PQDs within 30 calendar days post the Mentor Term completion.

## Recognition:

- Club Mentor Pin.



# Award: Shining Clubs

---

## Criteria:

- Clubs to achieve 5 DCP points by 31st December and become Distinguished on April 15, 2022.

## Eligibility:

- Club to be in good standing and not eligible for Diamond and Golden Club Award.

## Process:

- Verified through dashboard.

## Recognition:

- Trophy/Plaque for the Club.

# Award: Excellence in Education

---

## Criteria:

- Clubs to achieve 5 out of 6 Educational DCP points and to be distinguished by April 15, 2022.

## Eligibility:

- Club to be in good standing and not eligible for Diamond and Golden Club Award.

## Process:

- Verified through dashboard.

## Recognition:

- Trophy/Plaque for the VP Education.

# Award: Flag Bearer Award

---

## Criteria:

- New Clubs to be Distinguished by April 15, 2022, & Net Growth of +5 Members on top of Club membership base.

## Eligibility:

- Clubs Chartered on or after May 1, 2021, are eligible.

## Process:

- Verified through dashboard.

## Recognition:

- Club officer pin set.

# Award: Phoenix Award

---

## Criteria:

- Clubs to reach 20 member base and become Distinguished by April 15, 2022.

## Eligibility:

- Clubs having 12 or less than 12 membership base.

## Process:

- Verified through dashboard.

## Recognition:

- Club officer pin set.

# Award: Consistent Club

---

## Criteria:

- 20+ member renewals in both cycles and become Distinguished on April 15, 2022.

## Eligibility:

- Club to be in good standing and not eligible for Diamond Club Award.

## Process:

- Verified through dashboard.

## Recognition:

- Trophy/Plaque for the Club.

# Award: Trend Breaker Award

---

## Criteria:

- Clubs having 20+ members and become Distinguished by April 15, 2022.

## Eligibility:

- Clubs having 15 or less than 15 membership base from last 2 years.

## Process:

- Verified through dashboard.

## Recognition:

- Trophy/Plaque for the Club.

# Award: Leading Club Award

---

## Criteria:

- 20+ members post September renewals + 2 Members filing Level 1 + 2 Members filing Level 2 by October 15, 2021.
- 20+ members post March renewals + 2 Members filing Level 1 + 2 Members filing Level 2 by April 15, 2022.

## Eligibility:

- Club having less than 15 membership base count.

## Process:

- Verified through dashboard.

## Recognition:

- Trophy/Plaque for the Club.

# Award: Golden Club Award

---

## Criteria:

- Club to achieve 10/10 DCP points, renew at least 20 members in both renewal cycles & having net growth of +5 membership base by April 15, 2022.

## Eligibility:

- Club to be in good standing and not eligible for Diamond Club Award.

## Process:

- Verified through dashboard.

## Recognition:

- Trophy/Plaque for the Club.

# Award: Pre Smedley

---

## Criteria:

- Add three (3) new or dual or reinstated members in July 2021.

## Eligibility:

- Membership start date should be July 1, 2021, and membership fees paid by July 31, 2021, to TI.
- Club to be in good standing.

## Process:

- Data will be captured from the dashboard.

## Recognition:

- TI Merchandise for Club VP Membership.

# Award: Hello Smedley

---

## Criteria:

- Add five (5) new or dual or reinstated members between August 1, 2021, and September 30, 2021.

## Eligibility:

- Membership start date should be August 1, 2021, or September 1, 2021, and membership fees paid to TI by September 30, 2021.
- Club to be in good standing.
- Club should not have qualified for Smedley Award in 2020.

## Process:

- Data will be captured from the dashboard and report generated by TI.

## Recognition:

- Recognition by Toastmasters International.
- TI Merchandise for Club VP Membership.
- Additionally, if club base was below 20 on July 1, 2021, TI merchandise for Club President.

# Award: Smedley Top Up

---

## Criteria:

- Add four (4) additional new or dual or reinstated members between August 1, 2021, and September 30, 2021, as compared to such members added between August 1, 2020, and September 30, 2020.

## Eligibility:

- Membership start date should be August 1, 2021, or September 1, 2021, and membership fees paid to TI by September 30, 2021.
- Club to be in good standing.
- Club should have qualified for Smedley Award in 2020.

## Process:

- Data will be captured from the dashboard.

## Recognition:

- Recognition by Toastmasters International.
- TI Merchandise for VP Membership.

# Award: Super Sponsor

## Criteria:

- An individual member to sponsor 2 or 3 or 5 members in a month in any club in District 98 between July to September 2021.

## Eligibility:

- Membership start date should be between July and September 2021 and membership payment made before end of the respective month.
- Member sponsored details should reflect on the sponsors TI individual profile (i.e., at the time of member being added to a club, sponsor name should have been recognized).

# Award: Torch Bearer

---

## Criteria:

- Clubs in which minimum 10 members do annual renewals, during the September renewal cycle before October 31, 2021.

## Eligibility:

- Membership fees needs to be paid for October 2021 to September 2022.

## Process:

- Data will be captured from the membership report.

## Recognition:

- TI membership pin for all the members who complete annual renewal.
- Plaque for the club.

# Award: The Power of Two

---

## Criteria:

- New or Dual or Reinstated member joining a club between July 1, 2021, to September 30, 2021, and paying membership fees till March 31, 2022.

## Eligibility:

- Membership start date should be July 1, 2021, or August 1, 2021, or September 1, 2021, and paid to TI before September 30, 2021.

## Process:

- Data will be verified from the membership report.
- VP-Membership to submit through the form ([click link to open](#)) on behalf of the member by October 15, 2021.

## Recognition:

- TI merchandise for the member.



# Award: Exceeding Everest

---

## Criteria:

- Maximum net growth percentage in Membership count on September 30, 2021, as compared to July 1, 2021.

## Eligibility:

- New or dual or reinstated members joining date should be between July 1, 2021, and September 30, 2021.
- Club to be in good standing.

## Process:

- For July, base membership as per dashboard will be taken.
- For September, membership as on monthly closing date will be considered.

## Recognition:

- Trophy for top 3 clubs within each cluster of Divisions being ABJMSU, CDOPW, EFGHN.

# Award: Retention Champs

---

## Criteria:

- Retain and renew 75% base members by October 15, 2021 (and not membership count).

## Eligibility:

- Members part of the base membership (i.e., July 1, 2021) will only be considered.
- Club to be in good standing, and base membership needs to be 20 or above.

## Process:

- Data will be captured from the membership report.

## Recognition:

- TI Merchandise for all ExCom members.

# Annual Awards

# Award: Growth Leader

---

## Criteria:

- Member generated club lead that gets chartered during the program year.

## Eligibility:

- Applicable only for Corporate or Institutions or Rotary Toastmasters clubs being chartered till June 30, 2022.
- The lead needs to be submitted to CGD office for action.

## Process:

- Data will be verified from the dashboard.

## Recognition:

- Trophy for the member.

# Award: 3 Cheers

---

## Criteria:

- Club to achieve all three (3) Toastmasters membership building program i.e., Smedley Award, Talk up Toastmasters and Beat the Clock.

## Eligibility:

- All clubs in good standing.

## Process:

- Data will be captured from the report generated by Toastmasters International.

## Recognition:

- TI Merchandise for VP Membership of both cycles.

# Award: Helping Hand

---

## Criteria:

- Clubs who support a club with less than 15 members in conducting meetings, taking educational sessions and building membership to reach at least 20 members by December 31, 2021, and become a Distinguished Club in the current program year by May 31, 2022.

## Eligibility:

- Club being supported should have less than 15 base membership.
- Conduct at least 1 open house.

## Process:

- Clubs interested to take up the initiative should send an expression of interest to [cgdoffice@district98.org](mailto:cgdoffice@district98.org) before September 30, 2021.
- Status will be checked as per the dashboard.

## Recognition:

- Trophy for the supporting club.

# Award: Excellence in Administration (District stage)

---

## Criteria:

- Club Secretary who maintains minutes of all club meetings through the year, with any decisions ratified by the club membership.

## Eligibility:

- The minutes of meeting should cover a summary of the meeting and ensure to capture the General Evaluator recommendations (for the respective meeting). If the meeting is a special meeting, or the GE session is not conducted, the same is to be mentioned in the minutes.
- The Secretary must be trained during both TLTP cycles held by the respective Division/cluster

## Process:

- Maintain the prescribed minutes of meetings from July 1, 2021, to April 30, 2022. Submit intent to participate when the google form is launched by end of September 2021.
- The process would be in 2 parts; the first set of minutes (July 1, 2021, to November 30, 2021) to be emailed on or before December 5, 2021, the second set of minutes (December 1, 2021, to April 30, 2022) to be emailed on or before May 5, 2022.
- The folder with the relevant minutes to be compressed in a single folder, attached and emailed with the subject line: Administration award\_

# Award: Excellence in Logistics (District stage)

---

## Criteria:

- Club Sergeant at Arms (SAA) who participates in 75% of their home club meetings (regular, special, milestone or any other) as SAA.
- To participate in at least 2 events beyond the club level (joint meetings, contests, workshops etc.) as SAA or Zoom master. If the club has a semi-annual Executive Committee, both SAAs need to have at least 1 participation beyond club.

## Eligibility:

- The SAA must be trained during both TLTP cycles held by the respective Division/cluster.

## Process:

- Maintain the prescribed agenda of meetings from July 1, 2021, to April 30, 2022. Submit intent to participate when the google form is launched by end of September 2021.
- The process would be in 2 parts; the first set of agendas (July 1, 2021, to November 30, 2021) to be emailed on or before December 5, 2021, the second set of agendas (December 1, 2021, to April 30, 2022) to be emailed on or before May 5, 2022. Please ensure to attach the agenda of special event(s) in whichever cycle it may fall in.
- The folder with the relevant minutes to be compressed in a single folder, attached and emailed with the subject line: Logistics award\_ Club Name\_ Division Name to: [adminoffice@district98.org](mailto:adminoffice@district98.org).

- Submit intent to participate when the google form is launched by end of September 2021.

## Recognition:

- Social media recognition for the club, and plaque for Treasurers of both terms or one term, if annual tenure.

# Award: The PR Stalwart (Division Stage)

---

## Criteria:

For Club VP Public Relations who:

- Ensure promotional collaterals used are as per branding guidelines (including but not limited to posters, collaterals, agenda, zoom backgrounds, club standee and banner (physical or virtual)).
- Ideate and execute at least one innovative PR campaign to promote Toastmasters in their term.
- Attend all VP PR TLTP trainings in their term (one in case of 6-month club term, two in case of annual club term), and attend at least one external training organized by the DPRM team.

## Eligibility:

- No limitation on number of eligible VPs PR.

## Process:

- Upload to shared drive folder one example each of the collateral(s) created in their term in a .zip file.
- Share details of the innovative campaign and impact created either in .doc or .ppt (you can include posters that you used for the campaign)
- Attendance at COTP and PR training will be tracked by DPRM. Submission of intent by April 10, 2022.
